Appendix 1

Locality Budget Spend 2009-2010

This report details the total spend by Members in the financial year 2009-2010, highlights the value of the match funding and details the number of community based projects to benefit from Locality Budget Funding.

The table below shows that Members contributed a total of £58,737 to projects which benefited local communities within East Devon, with the match funding contributed towards these projects totalling £388,051. The Locality Budget contributions in East Devon Area represents just over 15% of the total funding secured to deliver a total of 80 projects; indicating both significant value for money and the value of these contributions in leveraging additional funding.

In accordance with the Locality Budget operating principles, the Council allows Members to carry forward any unallocated spend into the next financial year. Accordingly, the total spend available in 2010/2011 is £163,561

Examples of Locality Budget Funding Allocation

Exe Estuary Festival Spirit of the Exe.

This project demonstrates local businesses and statutory bodies coming together to support a festival to showcase and celebrate the Exe Estuary including the clubs and organisations that are vital to the life and vibrancy of the area. This total project cost was an estimated £2,650. 3 councillors from the area contributed £1,150 the balance being made up from other agencies and local businesses. A truly joint approach to funding.

Stockland Community Shop Start up

Locality funding was provided to support an event to promote interest in the setting up of a community shop. The supported group have well thought out plans which they need to test on the local community. Funding for this sort of event in a very rural location can be difficult to obtain. The locality fund of £250 alongside the Parish Council contribution of £250 enables the group to promote locally the formation of a community shop and monthly market.
