1. Summary

2. Actions on Advertised Traffic Orders

Since the last meeting of this Committee, a number of Traffic Orders have been progressed and where objections have been received, these have been dealt with by a consultation with the Chairman and local Members. Details of these matters are listed below.

Location	Proposal	Action
Various Roads	Introduction & removal of mandatory disabled parking bays	Traffic regulation order advertised, modified, objections resolved and order sealed after consultation with Local Member and HATOC Chair.
Longbrook Street	Loading bay	Traffic regulation order advertised after consultation with Local Member and HATOC Chair and then sealed due to no objections being received.
Fore Street & King Street	No Loading restriction to improve access for buses	Traffic regulation order advertised, objections resolved and order sealed after consultation with Local Member and HATOC Chair.
St Davids Hill	Changes to limited waiting & residents parking.	Traffic regulation order advertised after consultation with Local Member and HATOC Chair and then sealed due to no objections being received.
Western Way (near West Street)	Upgrade pedestrian crossing to Toucan	Public notice advertised after consultation with Local Member and HATOC Chair
