Appendix 1

Locality Budget Spend 2009-2010

This report details the total spend by Members in the financial year 2009-2010, highlights the value of the match funding and details the number of community based projects to benefit from Locality Budget Funding.

The table below shows that Members contributed a total of £33,942.05 to projects which benefited local communities within Mid Devon, with the match funding contributed towards these projects totalling £409,553. The Locality Budget contributions in Mid Devon Area represents just over % of the total funding secured to deliver a total of 71 projects; indicating both significant value for money and the value of these contributions in leveraging additional funding.

In accordance with the Locality Budget operating principles, the Council allows Members to carry forward any unallocated spend into the next financial year. Accordingly, the total spend available in 2010/2011 is £ 85.557.95

Examples of Locality Budget Funding Allocation

Junior Life Skills

All six Members contributed equally to a total of £600 for a programme of Junior Life Skills training for year six pupils reaching around 1,000 pupils drawn form all 44 primary schools in the Mid Devon area. The programme was supported by a wide range of agencies including the RNLI, St. Johns Ambulance and Western Power. It has not been possible to calculate the "in-kind" contribution from these agencies but it would have been substantial.

Bradninch Guildhall Replacement Heating System

This is a good example of the way in which a small grant of £500 provided a welcome boost to the fund-raising efforts to meet the cost of a replacement heating system for the hall (estimated to cost £24,000). Very often these small grants act to both stimulate and encourage the fund raisers to start their fund-raising, or to provide the final contribution needed to close the gap after all other potential funding routes have been pursued.
