Whitestone	30mph Speed Limit	Traffic regulation order advertised after consultation with Local Member and HATOC Chair and then sealed due to no objections being received.
A379	20mph, 30mph and 40mph Speed limits	
Drum Bridges Roundabout	Introduction of national speed limit following the installation of new street lights
