1. Context

3. Audit Arrangements

The recommendations of the Devon Audit Partnership were accepted and from now on:

- (a) Any allocation of a Members locality budget is dependent upon the recipient(s) formally agreeing to spend the funding on the activity and/or items specified on the application form, the recipient(s) agreeing to return any unspent monies. Members should maintain sufficient contact with recipient organisations so that they are able to identify the outputs/successes (or otherwise) of the funding granted, by asking the recipient to provide a simple statement of how the funding benefited the organisation and local community.
- (b) Where a scheme is jointly funded by one or more Members appropriate arrangements be made to ensure the necessary declaration is made once and the Chairman of the relevant County Committee will be asked to ensure appropriate monitoring takes place;
- (c) An analysis of expenditure from locality budgets across the County will be prepared and submitted to County Committees at the end of the financial year to enable Members to satisfy themselves that the principles of the scheme are being met.
