1. QUESTION FROM MR SHEEHAN Re: Isolation/purification of the sars cov 2 virus

My question concerns the isolation/purification of the sars cov 2 virus from a symptomatic patient with covid 19.

As of 28 September 2021, there have been over 100 responses to freedom of information requests to offices and institutions in over 20 countries around the world for records of the isolation of the sars cov 2 virus. None of the responses have provided evidence of the isolation and therefore proof of existence of the sars cov 2 virus. This includes responses from the UK Cabinet Office, UK House of Commons, UK House of Lords, UK Department for Health and Social Care, UK Prime Minister's Office, UK Government Office for Science, Public Health England, and Imperial College London.

Can Devon County Council provide evidence for the isolation/purification of the sars cov 2 virus?

I am not asking whether the Council believes the virus to exist, just simply whether it holds evidence confirming the virus exists in the form of a scientific paper showing isolation/purification from a symptomatic patient with covid 19. Please confine your answer to this specific issue.
