2. Actions on Advertised Traffic Orders

Since the last meeting of this Committee, a number of Traffic Orders have been progressed and where objections have been received, these have been dealt with by a consultation with the Chairman and Local Members. Details of these matters are listed below.

Traffic Order 5633 was advertised between 3 and 24 April 2018 and received no objections in relation to these two items. Order was sealed on 1 October 2018 and came into force on 12 October 2018.
New Street, Great Torrington the south side from a point 232 metres west of its junction with Whites Lane for a distance of 6.6 metres in a westerly direction.	To introduce a Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time
