Re: Major Road Network Schemes

On 11th June this year Glastonbury Town Council passed the following motion:

"With reference to the Southwest Peninsula Transport Group discussions to be reported back to council on 3rd July, this council is opposed to building any new roads on our flood plains around Glastonbury as a solution to the heavy traffic on the A361 through the town."

Therefore Glastonbury Town Council is opposed to the Glastonbury bypass proposals currently under consideration by Peninsula Transport, both the long and short routes.
