Countywide	Introduction of Care Workers permits and changes to Dispensation Permit scheme	Traffic regulation order advertised, objections resolved, and scheme implemented following consultation with the Cabinet Member for Highway Management and the Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care & Health Services.
Mill Street, Chagford	Introduction of mandatory disabled bay.	Traffic regulation order advertised, objection resolved, and bay implemented after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Chair.
Plymouth Road and Grenville Drive, Tavistock	Introduction of restrictions on an experimental basis	Experimental traffic regulation order implemented after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Chair.
