






## Magdalen Road Consultation

• 4 weeks From 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021


- 4 Options
  - 1 One Way westbound & contraflow cycle (as current)
  - 2a One way eastbound and contraflow cycle lane
  - 2b One way eastbound and no cycle lane
  - 3 low traffic street
  - 4 return to Two way






#### Magdalen Road - Consultation Results

- Consultation- 1500 Responses
- 75% in favour of reducing through traffic
  - >1100 in favour



#### Magdalen Road –Option Preference

- Consultation- 1500 Responses
  - 20% option 1 one way westbound
  - <5% option 2a & Option 2b
- >50% of respondents preference was low traffic street
  - 25% Return to two way traffic


- 20 Responses from Traders on Magdalen Road

#### Options - Summary

1- One way west			Retains on St parking

- Option 3- require external funding to deliver
- Option 3- Likely require return to two way until such time funding available
- Option 1- less disruptive, and lower risk to deliver

# Option 1 — Progress and further consultation with Traders on details Explore options for additional Traffic free days



#### Recommendation: It is recommended that:

- (a) proposals to widen the northern footway, restrict vehicular traffic to one-way westbound and provide a contra-flow (eastbound) on-road cycle lane on Magdalen Road, shown indicatively in Appendix I, are progressed for further consultation and detailed design; and
- (b) following further consultation, a Traffic Regulation Order required for the proposals on Magdalen Road be advertised; and
- (c) further monitoring be carried out on the impact of the Magdalen Road scheme on the local roads; and
- (d) the Head of Planning, Transportation and Environment be given delegated powers, in consultation with the Chair of HATOC and the local member, to make amendments to the scheme details for a preferred scheme for approval at a future meeting of Devon County Council's Cabinet.
