**FIN 684 - CAPITAL PROGRAMME**

**Capital Programme Increase**

**Flood and Coastal Resilience Innovation Programme - £656,000**

As part of the Flood and Coastal Resilience Innovation Programme, the Environment Agency have awarded Devon County Council grant funding in 2021/22. The project is called Managing Big Problems in Small Places and the initial award value is £656,000. The project aims to help communities be more resilient to flooding and coastal change. In total, capital funding of up to £7.6 million has been earmarked for Devon. A report to cabinet will be submitted, once more information is available.


Approval is sought to increase the Planning, Transportation and Environment 2021/22 Capital Programme by £656,000, funded by external grant.
