

2. Overall Attendance Figures


May 2021 - January 2022


May 2021 - January 2022

4. Induction Attendance Figures


May 2021 - November 2021

6. Discussion

This document was produced on the 17^{th of} January 2022 and considers all Members Inductions and Scrutiny Sessions organised by DSSS between June 2021 and January 2022.

Section 1 displays the recorded schedule of events. As of publication, 29 sessions have been organised for Members. This includes 13 Induction Sessions and 16 Scrutiny Masterclasses. These sessions have covered content from at least 8 different service areas and have all been held via Microsoft Teams.

Section 2 displays the overall attendance pattern for Members Inductions and Scrutiny Masterclass. Turnout was recorded at its highest in June, with 46 Members attending *Highways and Traffic Management Session 1* on the 04^{th of} June 2021. The average plotlines demonstrate a general decrease of attendance since June 2021. The mean average is 15 Members across all sessions, with 7 Members having attended over 50% of all sessions.

A plea was made before the Public Health Session in October 2021 for an increased turnout to all sessions, however attendance has seen little to no improvement.

Section 3 displays the attendance of Scrutiny Masterclass in greater detail. Attendance is low but steady, at a mean average of 11 Members across all Scrutiny Masterclasses.

Section 4 displays the attendance of Members Inductions in greater detail. Again, attendance is low but steady, at a mean average of 14 Members across all Members Inductions.

Section 5 displays the average attendance figures across different service areas. *Highways* garnered the highest average turnout of 32 Members, followed by *Treasury & Finance* at 14 Members.
