Actions Taken Under Delegated Powers

1. Summary

In accordance with Minute *4 of the Meeting of this Committee on 7 July 2021 this report details the actions taken in respect of traffic regulation orders under Delegated Powers since the last meeting.

2. Actions on Advertised Traffic Schemes

Since the last meeting of this Committee, a number of Traffic Orders have been progressed and where objections have been received, these have been dealt with by a consultation with the Chair and local County Councillors. Details of these matters are listed below.

Location	Proposal	Action
Countywide	Amendments to various parking restrictions to correct discrepancies within the traffic regulation order.	Traffic regulation order advertised and changes implemented after consultation with Cabinet Member for Highway Management as no objections received for proposals in this area.
Countywide	Changes to Care Workers Permits	Traffic regulation order advertised following Cabinet approval, with objections resolved and restrictions implemented after consultation with Cabinet Member for Highway Management and Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care & Health Services.

Wrangaton	Extension of 30mph speed limit by virtue of street lighting (Restricted Road)	Traffic regulation order advertised and implemented after consultation with Local County Councillors and HATOC Chair as no objections were received.
Cott Road, Dartington	Introduce residents parking and no waiting at any time.	Traffic regulation order advertised, objections received and not progressed following consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Chair.
Access Road of Townstal Road, Dartmouth	Upgrade advisory disabled bay to a mandatory disabled parking bay.	Traffic regulation order advertised and implemented after consultation with Local County Councillors and HATOC Chair as no objections were received.
Clare Street, Ivybridge	Introduce a new mandatory disabled parking bay.	Traffic regulation order advertised, objection resolved, and bay implemented after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Vice Chair.
Fore Street, Loddiswell	Removal of School Keep Clear outside former primary school and introduce no waiting at any time.	Traffic regulation order advertised, objection resolved, and removal progressed after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Vice Chair.
Moreleigh Cross to Stanborough, Halwell	Introduce a Prohibition of All Vehicles Except Access	Traffic regulation order advertised and implemented after consultation with Local County Councillors and HATOC Chair as no objections were received.
Mayors Avenue, Dartmouth	Introduce No Waiting At Any Time	Traffic regulation order advertised and implemented after consultation with Local County Councillors and HATOC Chair as no objections were received.
