1. Summary

2. Actions on Advertised Traffic Orders

Since the last meeting of this Committee, a number of Traffic Orders have been progressed and where objections have been received, these have been dealt with by a consultation with the Chair and local County Councillors. Details of these matters are listed below.

Location	Proposal	Action
Cranbrook Station Car Park	One Way, Pedestrian & Cycle Zone and parking restrictions	Traffic regulation orders advertised and restriction implemented following consultation with local members and Chair as no objections received.
Highwell Road, Seaton	Introduction of disabled parking bay	Traffic regulation order advertised and restriction implemented following consultation with local member and Chair as no objections received.
Maer Road, Exmouth	Introduction of Pay & Display and No Waiting At Any Time	Decision delegated following HATOC in July 2021. Restrictions relaxed in consultation with local member and Chair.
