- A quorum is achieved when a majority of Partners are represented at a committee meeting: and
- at least one of those present represents the Host Authority; and
- should any Partner only have one attendee, that person will hold and cast both votes for that Partner Authority.

This would at present require a minimum of four of the Partners to be represented and would result in a minimum of eight votes being cast on any decision, action or motion.
