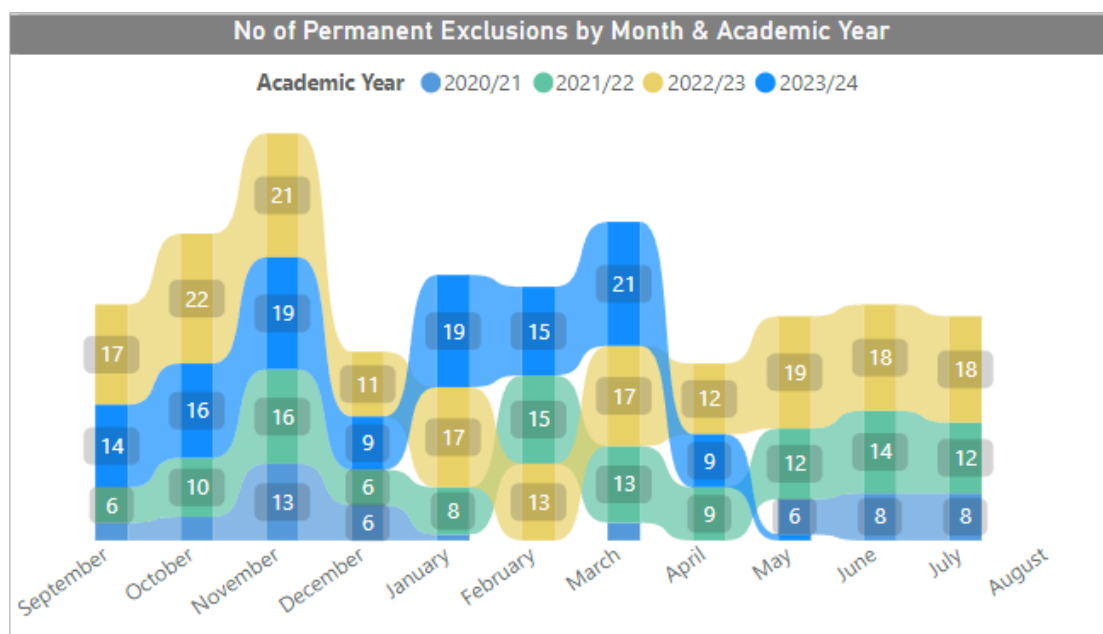

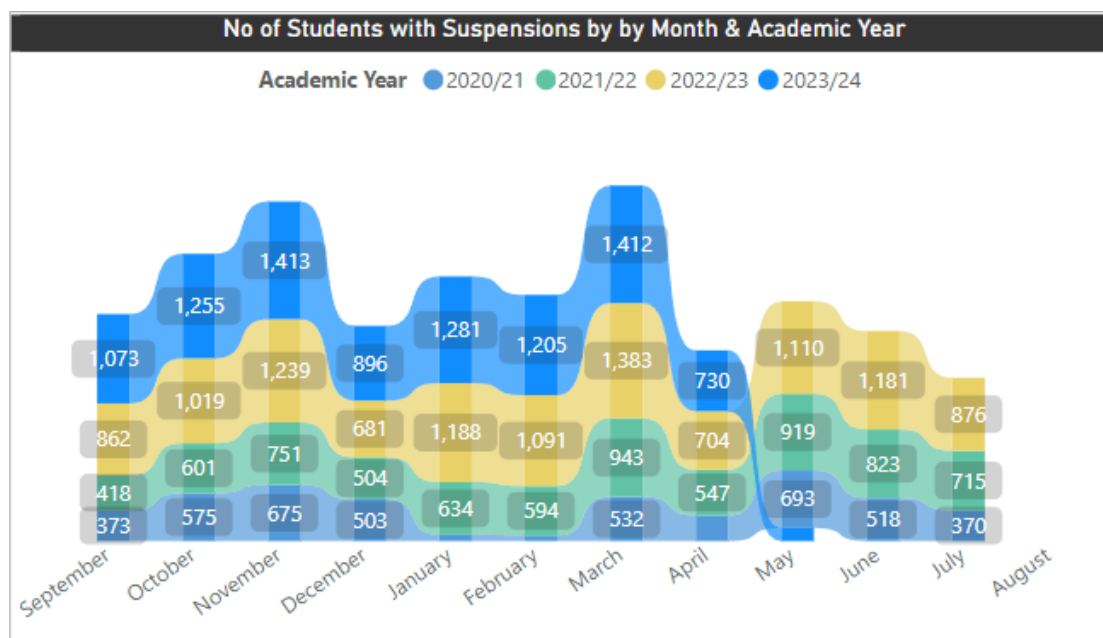

### Permanent exclusions

- Our overall rate is in line with nationally (0.04% of pupil population).

- Devon primary schools are in line with nationally (0.01% of population) and Devon secondaries are close to national (0.08% in Devon, 0.07% nationally).
- Devon special schools are significantly higher than nationally, 0.24% of pupil population in Devon special schools compared to 0.02% nationally.

#### Suspensions – pupils with more than one suspension rate

- Our overall rate is higher than nationally, with 2.35% of Devon’s pupil population having one or more suspension, 1.78% nationally.
- Devon primary schools have slightly higher rates than nationally (0.41% compared to 0.35%) but secondaries have significantly higher rates than nationally (5.11% compared to 3.58% nationally).
- Devon special schools have lower rate than nationally (1.92% compared to 2.23% nationally)

#### FSM pupils

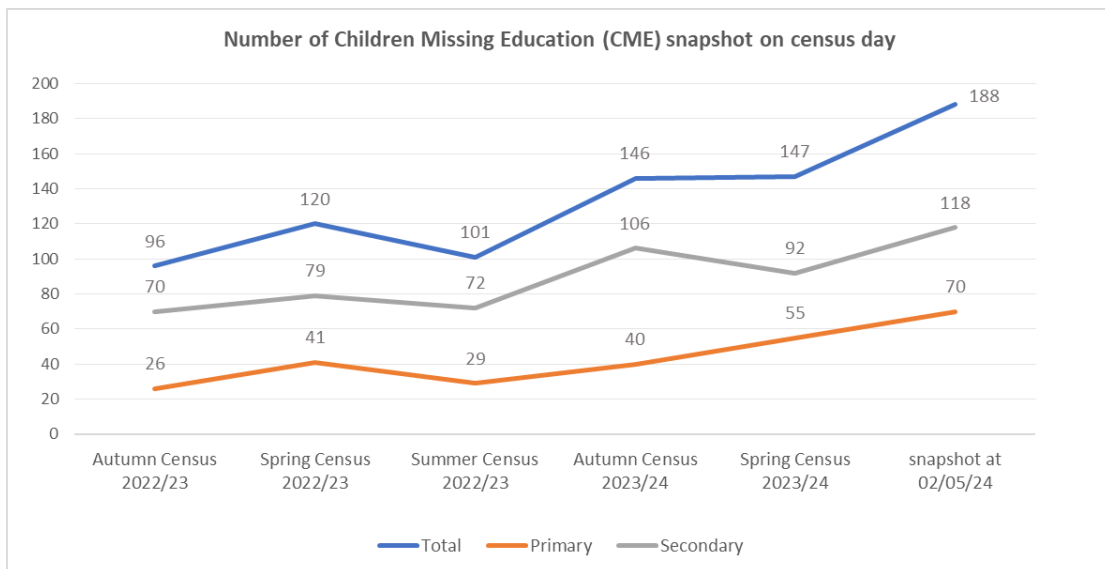
- A higher percentage of FSM pupils have one or more suspensions when compared to non FSM pupils (5.68% of Devon FSM pupils compared to 1.62% of Devon non FSM pupils).
- the rate of suspensions for Devon FSM pupils was 14.04, the equivalent of 1,404 suspensions for every 10,000 FSM pupils. This is significantly higher than the rate for Devon non FSM pupils which was 3.18 (318 suspensions for every 10,000 non FSM pupils). Devon’s rates are higher than nationally.
- The permanent exclusion rate for Devon FSM pupils is 0.16% compared to 0.01% of non FSM pupils. Devon’s FSM rate is significantly higher than nationally (0.09%).

## National and regional benchmarks for CME

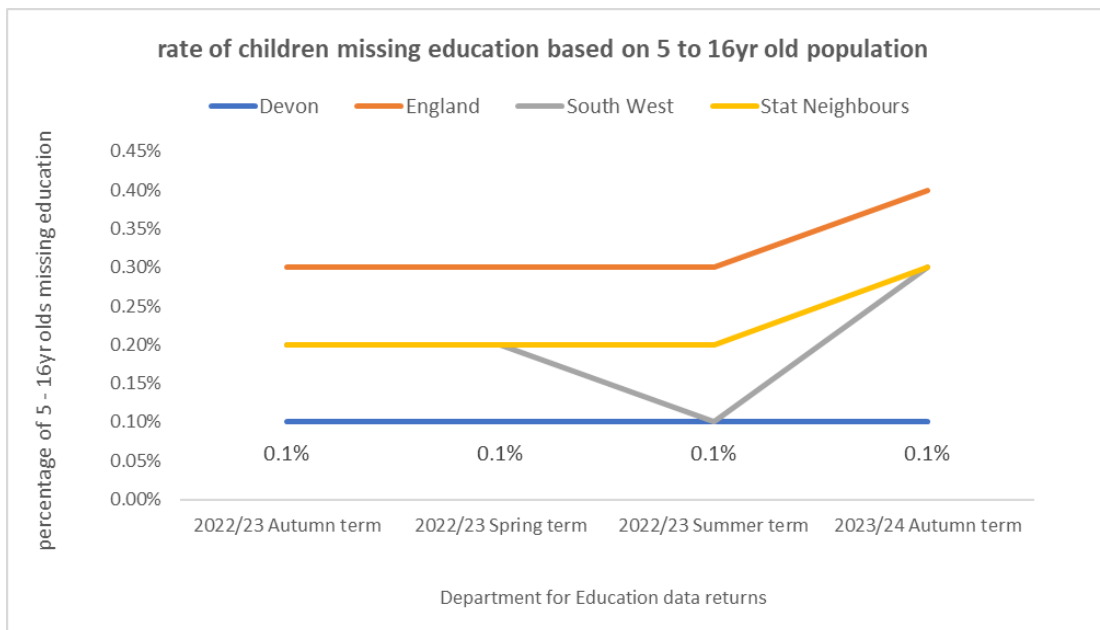
Whilst the number of Devon children missing education has risen slightly in each census, the rate of children missing education (based on 5 to 16yr old population) has remained stable.

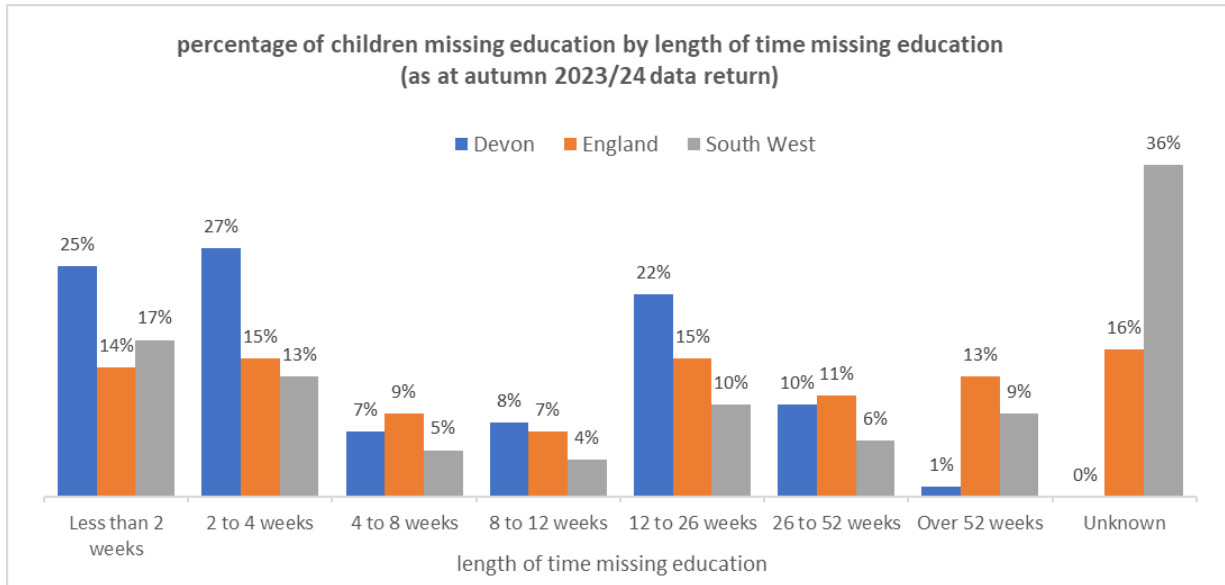
Devon has fewer children missing education than nationally and regionally.

Nationally the rate of children missing education has risen each census but has remained stable within Devon. The DfE advise that as this is a new data collection, the increases are likely to be in part due to improvements in data quality and recording practices.

Children missing education are more prevalent in secondary school age children, this is the case both in Devon and nationally.

The length of time a child was missing education was collected for the first time in Autumn 2023. Of the total children missing education in Devon on autumn 2023/24 census day, 52% were missing education for 4 weeks or less, significantly better than nationally (29%). 33% of Devon children were missing education for more than 12 weeks, compared to 39% nationally.
