Location	Proposal	Action
Buckerell	Extension to 30mph speed limit	Traffic order advertised and changes implemented after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Chair as no objections received.
Seaton Seafront	Changes to bus stops	Traffic order advertised, objections resolved and changes implemented after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Chair.
Nasmith Close, Exmouth	Introduction of disabled parking bays	Traffic order advertised, objections resolved (where applicable) and changes implemented after consultation with Local County Councillors and HATOC Chair.
Douglas Avenue, Exmouth	Changes to waiting restrictions as part of pedestrian crossing	Traffic order advertised and changes implemented after consultation with Local County Councillor and HATOC Chair as no objections received.
