Public Inquiry, Informal Hearing and Written Representation Decisions; Directions and High Court Appeals

Report of the Chief Officer for Highways, Infrastructure Development and Waste

Please note that the following recommendation is subject to consideration and determination by the Committee before taking effect.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the report be noted and, following the Secretary of State's direction in respect of item (a)(iii), that members give authorisation for an Order to be made adding the footpath as shown between points V – W – X on drawing number HTM/PROW/14/83.

1. Summary

Since the last Committee the following decisions and directions have been received from the Secretary of State/High Court. Plans are attached in the appendix to this report.

Order/Schedule 14 Application	Decision/Direction
(i) Footpaths No. 8, Northleigh, No. 3, Farway, No. 6, Colyton and No. 10, Southleigh Definitive Map Modification Order 2013	Order not confirmed: An order for the deletion of the paths was made following a direction from the Secretary of State as a result of a successful Schedule 14 appeal. The order was not confirmed following the written representations procedure on 29 September 2016. We have subsequently been notified that the Inspector's decision is being taken to Judicial Review of behalf of the applicant.
(ii) Schedule 14 Applications for the addition of a footpath between the road near Carpenter's Hill, in Combe Raleigh, and Greenway Lane near Greenway Manor, in Luppitt (Combe Raleigh proposal 9/Luppit proposal 10)	Appeal dismissed: Applicant's appeal to the Secretary of State against Devon County Council's decision not to make an order in respect of the schedule 14 applications dismissed on 26 September 2016.
(iii) Schedule 14 Applications for the addition of a footpath from the Dunkeswell to Honiton Road near Combe House, in Combe Raleigh, to the minor county road near Lower Shelvin Farm, in Luppitt, (Combe Raleigh proposal 8/Luppit proposal 9)	Appeal allowed: Applicant's appeal to the Secretary of State against Devon County Council's decision not to make an order in respect of the applications was allowed on 17 October 2016. Accordingly, the Secretary of State has directed the County Council to make an order to

add a public footpath as shown between points V – W – X on
drawing no. HTM/PROW/14/83.






