DISPENSATION FOR MEMBERS & CO-OPTED MEMBERS OF DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL 2014/17

In accordance with Part 3 of the County Council's Constitution (Responsibility for Functions - Scheme of Delegation) I hereby declare that, for the period 20 February 2014 to the date of the ordinary County Council elections in 2017, all Members and Co-opted Members of the County Council shall not be regarded as having a disclosable pecuniary interest as defined in the Council's Code of Conduct and have been granted a dispensation to permit them to speak and vote at meetings of the County Council, its Cabinet or any Committee, Sub-Committee, Joint Committee or Working Party thereof if the matter relates to any of the following functions of the County Council, namely:

- if a Member or Co-opted Member is a parent or guardian or carer of a child in full-time education, on any matter relating to **school meals or school transport** unless it relates specifically to the school a Member's child attends;
- If a Member or Co-opted Member is an approved foster parent, providing placements for the Council's Children in Care unless it relates specifically to a placement with that Member.
- any **allowance, travelling expenses, payment or indemnity** for Members or Co-opted Members of the Council;
- if you are receiving or eligible to receive **statutory sick pay**, under Part X1 of the Social Security and Benefits Act 1992, as amended;
- any **ceremonial honour** to be given to Members;
- the **setting of the Council Tax or Precept** or fees and charges arising therefrom by virtue, for example, of any of the above and as a consequence of a Member being a land or property owner in the administrative County of Devon;
- if a Member is a representative of the County Council on any County Council **wholly owned, controlled or joint local authority company or Joint Venture Partnership** on any matter relating thereto unless it relates to any personal remuneration or involvement therein.
