

Wider Devon Sustainability and Transformation Plan

Recommendation:

The Devon Health and Wellbeing Board is asked to note the update on progress of the Sustainability and Transformation Plan and suggest opportunities for increased alignment to support delivery of the Health and Wellbeing Strategy

Introduction:

The wider Devon Sustainability and Transformation Plan, initially published on 4th November 2017, sets the vision and strategic direction for health, wellbeing and care services across the areas covered by NEW Devon and South Devon and Torbay Clinical Commissioning Groups.

This Plan has previously been presented to the Devon Health and Wellbeing Board and this current submission provides an update on the current work and progress with this plan, and the development of a Sustainability and Transformation Partnership.

Aims and priorities:

As one of 44 Sustainability and Transformation Plans in England, the wider Devon Plan is focused on aims to:

- Improve health and wellbeing
- Deliver safe and high quality care
- Provide cost-effective care

Locally the priorities of the Plan are:

1. Prevention
2. Integrated care model
3. Primary care
4. Mental health and learning disability
5. Acute care
6. Children and young people
7. Productivity
