





Other Headlines

- Covid-19 specific deaths, and Covid-19 patients in high dependency or intensive care units remain low
- Current total deaths in line with seasonal averages
- Around 1 in 45 people people are currently affected by Long Covid (symptoms 12+ weeks after first infection)
- Omicron sub-variants BA.4 and BA.5 increasing and now account for majority of cases. 57.4% in week ending 11th June compared with 42.0% in previous week
- 79 Covid-19 cases in Devon hospitals (33 Royal Devon, 42 Derriford, 4 Torbay), with two in high dependency beds
